The base text for this edition is the final typescript TS. It is emended to take in HHR's revisions to TS (TSR) and variants in E1 which are judged to be HHR's proof corrections.

Where the adopted reading is from TS it appears to the left of the bracket without symbol; when other than TS it appears with the symbol denoting its origin. Variant readings with their source symbol appear to the right of the bracket. Unless noted, it can be assumed that subsequent states in the chronological order of the above list agree.
